Statement of Credentials for The School of the Great Commission

The School of the Great Commission was chartered by the State of South Carolina in 2003 as a Non-Profit Organization and in 2004 as a Post-Secondary Religious Institutions under Code 59.58.30 of the Nonpublic Post-Secondary Religious Institutions Act of Title 59. Under the leadership of Founder and Chancellor, Rev. Dr. Winford Thompson, the School received exemptions from the South Carolina Commission on Higher Education to operate as a Bible School. The purpose of the school is designed to offer educational training in the areas of Theology, Ministry, Divinity and Biblical Matters. It is approved to offer earned Certificates, Associates, Bachelors and Master degrees in Biblical Studies. The School is also qualified to offer Doctorate degrees in Biblical Studies. In addition, we are authorized to offer and present, Honorary Doctorate Degrees. The School is headquartered in South Carolina and is authorized to operate World-Wide in the area of Religious Studies.

Under the leadership of our Board of Trustees and Chancellor the school has obtained Accreditation from the International Accreditation Commission of Christian Educational Institutions, Accrediting Commission for Biblical Higher Education, American Accrediting Association of Theological Institutions, QHE Association the Southeastern Associations of Bible Colleges. The School holds licensing memberships in the Triune Professional Association and the National Christian Counselors Association. The school is also a Chartered/Founding Member of the National Association of Bible Colleges/Schools of Theology. In 2014, the School partnered with the International Bible Institute and has member organizations in several foreign countries.

Distant Learning Process

- 1. All Classes will be available on Zoom, Facebook Group, Conference Call, locally in-person and Independent Studies. Each student will have their option of type of study and method. All students will be presented with a General Studies Binder/textbook at Orientation and major concentrated binder/textbook each session.
- 2. Each month throughout the year with graduation several times throughout year in various locations. This is a twelve month academic term that includes a two week winter and summer break.
- 3. Students in our Distant/Virtual Learning Program will be assigned a class schedule. The class meetings will be using one of our Virtual methods. Each region will host a monthly four-five hour workshop.
- 4. Each Region will have a Regional Coordinator that will be available to answer any questions or concerns about your Academic Session. These Coordinators will also coordinate the monthly workshops and end of session graduation. The Coordinator will also sponsor Special Workshops throughout the school term for students and the community.
